## **Present Controls:**

- Health and safety briefing given at the beginning of each workshop.
- Guidance and safety briefing given before the use of the mangle.
- School groups must be on a tour with a tour guide.
- Group welcomed in Castleyard by Workshop Leader.
- Hand washing facilities in the toilets and in the Key Learning Centre
- Group taken from the Key Learning Centre to the Attraction by Tour Guide and returned to the Key Learning Centre afterwards to minimise contact with the public.
- Mound inspected by the team in the morning.
- Mound closed if path is too slippery.
- · School staff supervise toilet breaks and lunch time.
- Guests are warned to mind their heads as they enter St George's Tower.
- Guests are warned about the stairs and how many there are in St George's Tower
- Guests have the option to remain at the bottom should they not want to climb the stairs.
- Tour Guides radio to ensure St George's Tower is clear before ascending or descending the tower.
- Tour guides warn of uneven floor in the crypt.
- Team trained on the different workshops.
